- 1. Staffing for 2016-2017: We anticipate that we will be getting our staffing from our director sometime this week.
- Report Period in March was very successful. We had wonderful student led conferences throughout the school and the provincial report cards were very thorough, detailed and should have given our parents a great indication how their children are doing in our school to the present time.
- 3. Staffing update to date. We have Mrs. Copetti joining us as a teacher support for programming during the afternoons for the rest of this school year.
- 4. Secretary's Day is on Wednesday April 27th. We are so blessed to have Ms. Gomes, Mrs. McCallum and Mrs. Danner in our office. Your kids and our staff are in great hands with them around.
- 5. Timetable and Bell Change is working out very well. More teacher supervision outside and less transition time in the school.
